Productivity Matters are half day feature events taking place in both Glasgow and Edinburgh on Thursday 27 February 2020.

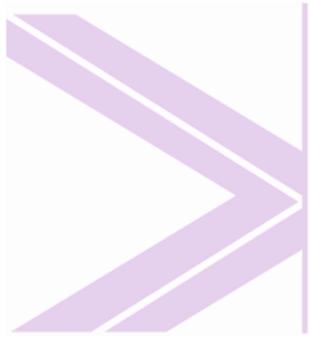
Choose your location and join fellow Club members for sessions which address areas where businesses are facing productivity challenges.
